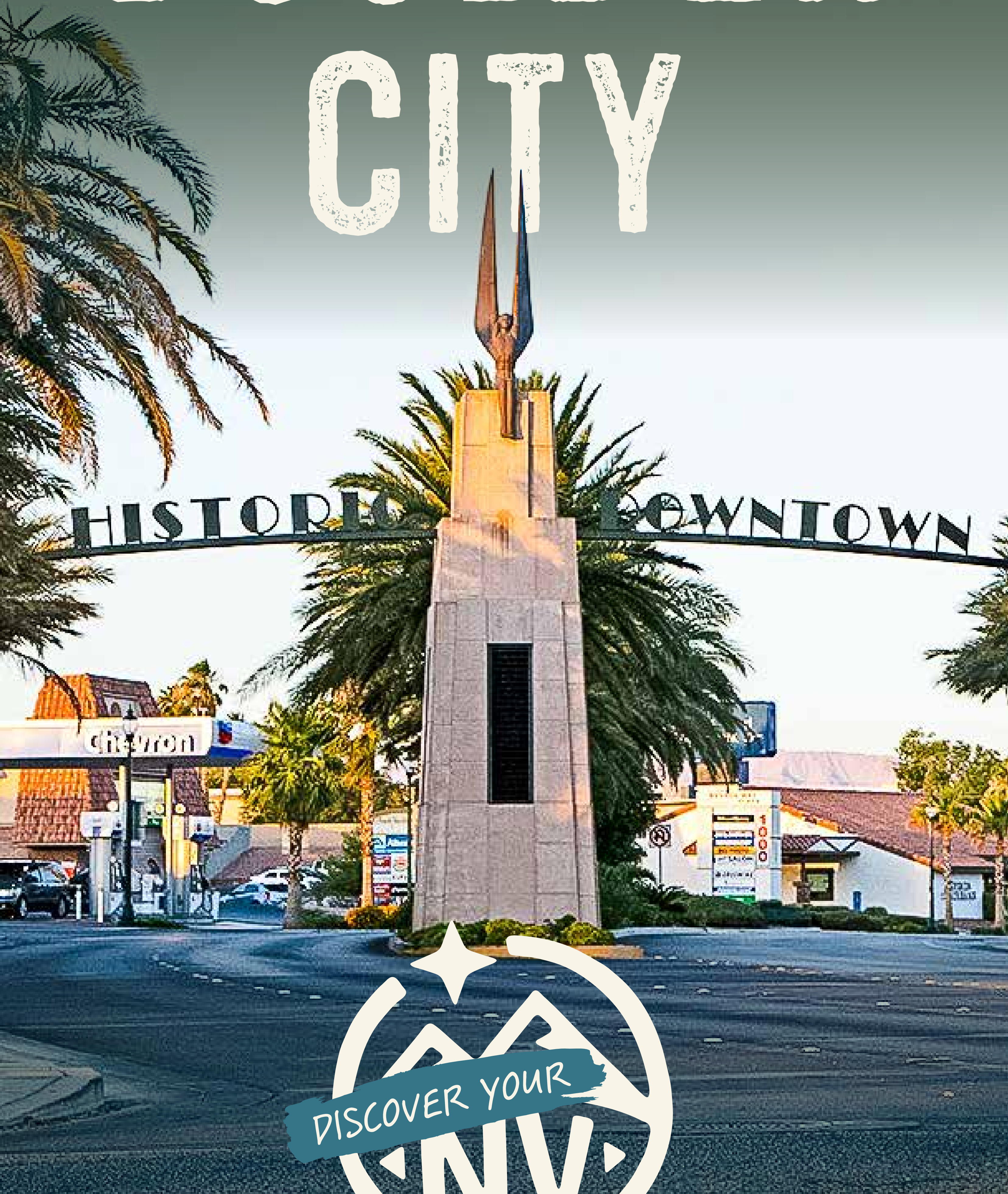

- > During outdoor recreational pursuits, enjoy that fresh Nevada air! Just have face coverings at the ready for when you cross paths with others.

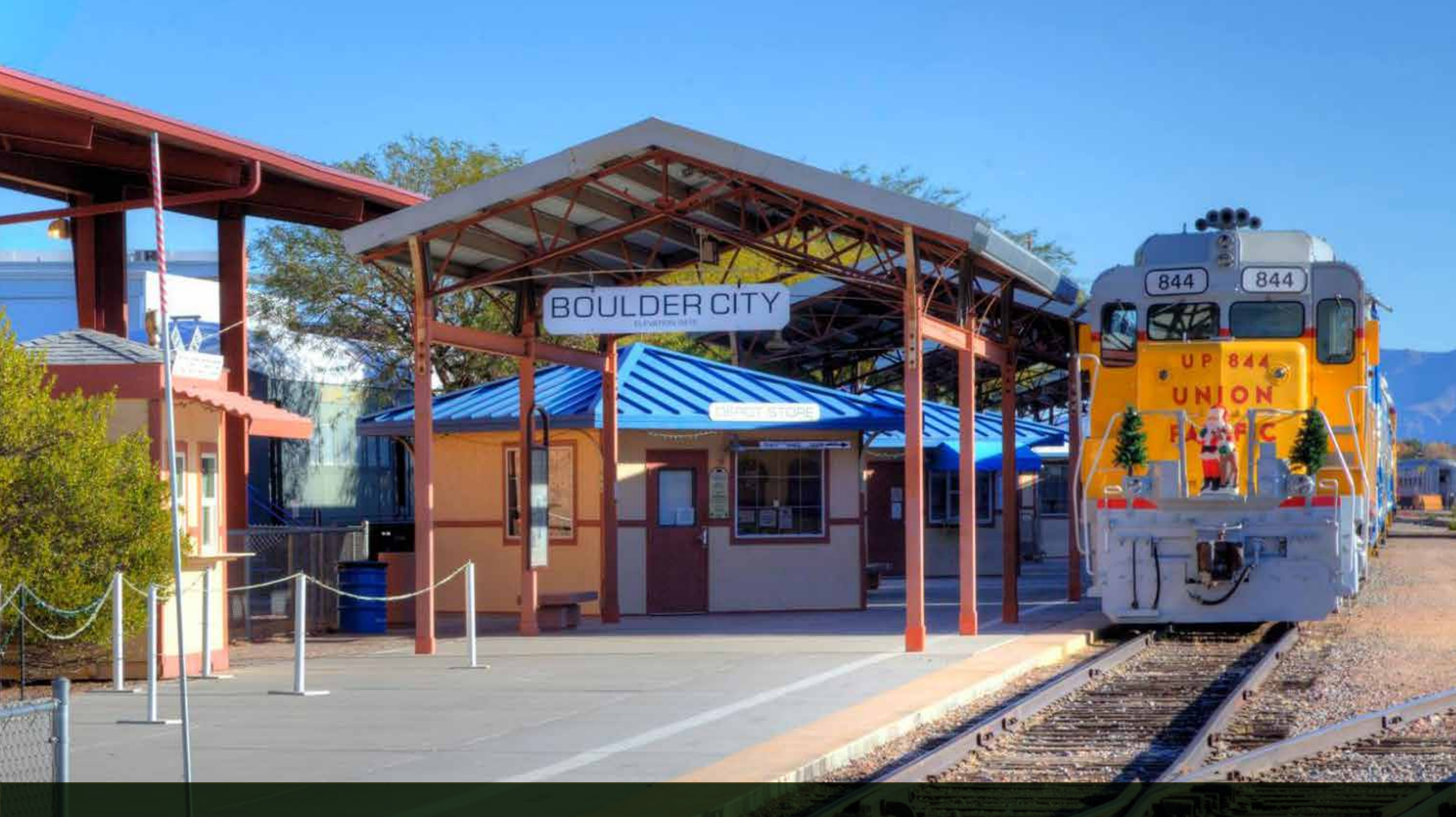
HOOVER'S HIATUS
